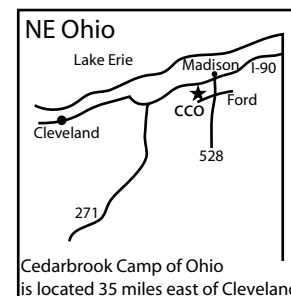

Note: Upon receipt of your registration, we will send you an itemized confirmation letter; all other forms are available on the Cedarbrook Camp of Ohio website (ie. a health history/health exam form, a parent questionnaire, and a list of what your child should bring). The camp week begins with **Sunday check-in (2-4pm)** and ends with **Saturday pickup (9:30am)**. Cedarbrook Camp does not provide weekend accommodations for campers attending more than one week of camp.

Outpost (Girls: Week 2, grades 10-12) Develop wilderness-survival skills: learn to read a compass, swing an axe, set up a tent, conquer beginning knots and lashing, cook exotic meals over an open fire, and more! Campers will spend three days and nights at a campsite that they will develop deep in the woods. **(Outpost is required for CILT 1 girls.)**

Riding Program (Grades 5-12) Campers are placed in appropriate skill level classes by the horsemanship specialist when they go through the registration line. Class sizes are limited by the number of horses available (two campers per horse). Settler level horsemanship (Grade 5) is an exploratory activity only. Advanced level campers may sign up for one or two class periods. Fee is \$45 per activity period.
